With a legacy gift to the Museum, you can have a lasting impact for your family, friends, and community. EXPLORE LEGACY GIVING

Gifts From Your Will

This very popular option is the easiest and most flexible way for you to have a lasting impact on the Museum while maintaining control over your assets throughout your lifetime. By including a gift in your will or trust, you can designate a specific dollar amount, a particular asset, or a percentage of your estate. If you already have a will, you may amend it to include a gift to the Museum.

Beneficiary Designations

This option can be as simple as completing a form that names the Museum as either the primary or contingent beneficiary. Your gift can be made from all or a portion of a:

- Bank Account
- Investment Account
- IRA, 401(k), or other Qualified Retirement Plan
- Annuity
- Life Insurance Policy

You may designate a fixed dollar amount or a percentage of the gift and you maintain complete control over the asset during your lifetime.

Advantages of a Retirement Plan Gift

Creating a legacy gift from your retirement plan can be an especially appealing option. By designating the Museum as the beneficiary of all or a portion of your estate, you can ensure that the amount of your gift will not be included in your taxable estate. The gift will be transferred tax-free from the retirement plan to the Museum, thereby reducing taxes and increasing available assets for your heirs.

Charitable Gift Annuity – Gifts That Pay Income

With a charitable gift annuity, you can create a meaningful contribution to the Museum while receiving income for yourself and/or a chosen beneficiary for the rest of your lives. This "Life Income Option" ensures mutual benefits for both you and the Museum.

How A Gift Annuity Works:

In exchange for a gift of at least \$10,000 in cash or securities to the Museum, dependable payments are made for life for up to two beneficiaries.

- You and/or your beneficiary receive fixed guarterly payments for life.
- The attractive rate of the payments is determined by the age (70 or older) and the number of annuitants (one or two).
- You can begin receiving payments immediately (if you are 70 or older) or defer payments for a year or more.
- You are eligible for an immediate income tax deduction. If you donate appreciated assets, you may also save on capital gains taxes.
- A portion of the annuity payment may be considered a tax-free return on principal.
- Recent tax law changes make gift annuities even more attractive for those 70½ or older: you can make a tax-free, one-time qualified charitable distribution of up to \$50,000 from your IRA to fund a charitable gift annuity.
