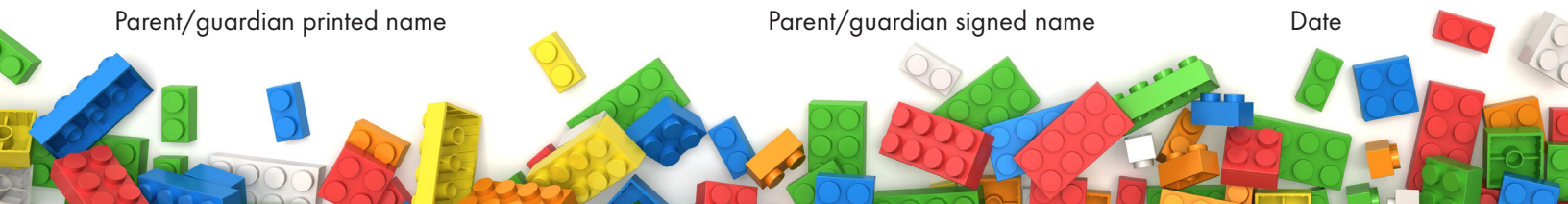

OFFICIAL RULES

- All artists are limited to ONE submission.
- There are four age categories, with a winning artist or group of artists selected in each: ages 3–5, 6–9, 10–14, 15–18. This contest is intended for youth artists; artists aged 19 and older will not be considered.
- Artwork can be no larger than 18" x 18" x 18".
- Submissions must be original pieces of art and fully created by the entrant.
- Submissions must be created solely from LEGO brand bricks or products. The Museum will not provide any LEGO bricks or other building materials.
- Submissions should not utilize any licensed characters (e.g., superheroes, Star Wars, SpongeBob, etc.)
- Artwork cannot come directly from kits nor infringe upon anyone's intellectual property rights.
- All submissions must include at least one clear photo of the artwork for judging purposes. Email submission photos should be in a jpeg or PDF format.
- Artwork will be judged by the exhibit designers and producers. All decisions of the judges are final.
- **Winners will be notified by email and/or telephone no later than May 8, 2020.**
- **All winning artists will receive**
 - Six (6) complimentary tickets to the exhibition.
 - Credit for their work as part of the display.
(only first names and first letter of last name, age of artist, and title of piece will be included in the credit).
 - An autographed copy of Nathan Sawaya's book *The Art of the Brick: A Life in LEGO*.
- **It is the responsibility of the winners to deliver the winning artwork to the Denver Museum of Nature & Science by May 22. The Museum is not responsible for transportation to or from the Museum.**
- Winners who wish to participate in the display will be expected to sign a release form for photography and/or media productions, release of liability, and statement of eligibility.
- Winning artworks will be displayed at the Denver Museum of Nature & Science while *The Art of the Brick* is at the Museum. Final display dates will be at the discretion of the Museum.
- It is the responsibility of the winners to pick up any displayed pieces from the Denver Nature & Science within three weeks of notification through mutual arrangement. Pieces remaining at the Museum shall be deemed unclaimed pieces.
- The Denver Museum of Nature & Science accepts no responsibility or ownership of the artworks, including but not limited to breakage, intellectual property infringement, or any unclaimed pieces.
